

## Face to Face lesson resumes at all campuses

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are pleased to announce that face to face learning will resume at all North Shore campuses from tomorrow, 21<sup>st</sup> August 2021, Saturday (Week 7).

North Shore will be operating within the parameters and restrictions stipulated by the Queensland government. This includes:

- Face masks are to be worn by everyone attending North Shore aged 12 years and older. This requirement is aged based and not class level based.
- Face masks are only to be removed for drinking and eating. Drinking and eating can only be undertaken when sitting down.
- Face masks are highly encouraged for students who are under 12 years of age.
- North Shore retains the right to request students who are not conforming with these requirements to leave.
- Teachers and staff are highly encouraged to be vaccinated.
- Social distancing applies as far as reasonably practicable, including current drop-off/pick-up procedures at all Campuses will be maintained.
- All attendees of a North Shore campus, including students who possess a smart phone, are to sign-in using the Queensland Government Check In Application. North Shore maintains roll books for all classes, which can be used for contact tracing, if required.
- Students, teachers and staff are not to attend North Shore if:
  - You or someone in your household are feeling unwell in ANY way, including a sore throat, mild cough or runny nose;
  - You have been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or with a suspected case of COVID-19;
  - You have travelled to a known hotspot in the last 14 days or if you have been in contact with someone who has travelled to a known hotspot;
  - You have been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results, or if someone in your household is waiting for a test result; and
  - You have been directed by Queensland Health to self-quarantine, or if someone from your household has been directed by Queensland Health to self-quarantine.

Notably, these are the same requirements which currently applies to schools.
