#### Rollout of new Enrolment Administration System (EASy) and Termination of existing North Shore Online payment facility

At North Shore Coaching College, we are always looking for ways to improve the student and customer experience. As part of transitioning into a modern education organisation, we are delighted to advise that we have transitioned to a new Student Enrolment Administration System.

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You will **no longer be able to pay your tuition fees using the existing North Shore Online transfer payment facility** and **suggest that you delete any account details** you have saved into your Internet Banking facility to avoid any confusion.

By now, you will have received an email to check your child's enrolment details via a link to your 'Statement of Accounts'. Following the link will bring up your child's enrolment details for Term 4, as well as your unique BPAY details at the bottom of the page (please refresh your browser if prompted).

If you have not received this email, **please check** your junk/spam box before contacting your campus manager.

Your patience and cooperation are requested as we roll out this system to better service you.

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# Our payment options have changed!

North Shore Coaching College is **no longer accepting online payments via our now retired Online transfer payment facility**. Instead, we have introduced new and more convenient methods for parents to pay tuition fees.

In addition to **cash and credit card payments in person**, we are now also accepting **BPAY payments**. Parents wishing to pay over the phone will be sent a secure link to your mobile and/or email, where you can personally enter your credit card details. This replaces the original method of staff asking for credit card details over the phone.

Regardless of payment method, enrolments are only confirmed once payment has cleared, so **please make use of your new convenient payment methods and do not leave re-enrolment to the last minute.**


