THE IMPORTANCE OF SILENT READING

Sustained silent reading has been an important part of the weekly timetable for many schools since I started teaching over three decades ago. The latest research indicates that it is still crucial for developing fundamental literacy skills.

It is important, however, that it is not left up to the school to ensure your child reads silently each day. To maximise your child's literacy skills, comprehension and fluency, it is important that silent reading takes place at home on a regular basis.

So how do you fit silent reading time into an already overcrowded schedule of sport, homework and extra-curricular activities? Here are 3 simple suggestions:

- 1. On the car ride to and from school
- 2. Establish a ritual of 15 minutes silent reading at bedtime before lights out
- 3. Establish a ritual of 15 minutes before breakfast a weekend treat if your child can successfully tell you what they read each day during the preceding week.



It is important that your child:

- reads each day to build a sustainable habit;
- is able to select books they find interesting and engaging;
- has the opportunity to share with you what they have read.

It is important that as a parent that you:

- take interest in what they share about their reading experience - they will value what you value:
- also read silently each day/night modelling the behaviour is a very powerful message you send to your child.

Of course, the ideal situation would involve the family taking out 20 minutes a night for 3 nights a week where everyone reads silently. A book, an iPad, newspaper or magazine. The source is not as important as the fact that everyone is reading! This modelling sends a strong, silent message to your child that reading is important and you place a high value on it.

Recent action research undertaken by Queenwood School for Girls has been consistent with earlier studies that revealed the importance of modelling reading behaviour. The students demonstrated increased interest in books that the teachers were themselves reading and even showed interest in reading their teacher's favourite books. This also resulted in an increased interest in more classic books.

Remember, you were the first teacher your child encountered. Your influence will continue throughout their life. The effort you put in to establishing their reading habits is as influential as that of their teachers.



Some Recommended Reading

As earlier stated it is important that students selfselect their reading material however you can supplement their choices. Enid Blyton's 'Famous Five' and 'Secret Seven' series can still win new fans even after many decades since their first release. I am personally a big fan of Emily Rodda and particularly the Rowan of Rin series for the wonderfully descriptive passages and the portrayal of an 'ordinary' boy who overcomes fear and a lack of expectation to become his own person. A multitude of literature is available to help young girls navigate their early years and become empowered women. The website: amightygirl.com has many interesting recommendations including a favourite, "The Paper Bag Princess", which teaches young girls they can be their own knight in shining armour.

For me, teaching is still one of the great joys of my life and the opportunity to share wonderful literature with children is a cornerstone of that joy. At North Shore we take pride in walking with your child on their learning journey.
