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Important Guidelines for Creative Writing Homework

Parents are encouraged to keep a loose eye on their children as they complete their creative writing homework. Tasks should be handwritten specifically instructed to (unless use computer), as this helps students engage more deeply with the material and cultivate their unique voice.

By writing by hand, children can better organize their thoughts and ideas on paper, helping to enhance their narrative skills and creativity. practice Additionally, this reduces the temptation of relying on AI tools for assistance, promoting independence and original thinking.

Please ensure that homework is legible; if you find it difficult to read, there's a strong chance that your child's teacher will struggle as well!

Be aware that homework submitted in a computer-processed format will not be accepted unless explicit parental consent has been provided to the office.

Student Reports available in Week 10

Remember to log in to the Student Portal following your last lesson in Week 10 to view and download your child's Term 2 Student Reports.

This is a great opportunity to praise their hard work and dedication, and to collaboratively set new goals for the next term. Remember, celebrating even small achievements can boost confidence and inspire further progress.

North Shore recommends families to **download** a copy for offline viewing and future reference.

Important: Reports will only be issued to students who have attended the majority of the term.







ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE FRIEND OR FOE?

Technology affects all our lives, and we are living in an age where it is almost impossible to keep us with the advances technology is making. No one is immune to this rapid pace of change - not even our children.

The most challenging area of technological change is in the field of artificial intelligence (AI).

For all the benefits that AI may bring us, there are some notable concerns. For educators the most unsettling concern is ensuring student work is original and not 'machinegenerated'.

At North Shore Coaching College, we are increasingly aware that students are using AI to generate their school homework and assignments. Whilst Al will provide quick answers, it will not ensure the student is actually *learning* - that they are *developing* skills and knowledge. When they are faced with an exam, especially an important one to gain admission to a selective school or secure a scholarship, students will be at a disadvantage if they have not the actually learnt important concepts and skills.

Zero Tolerance:

For that reason, North Shore Coaching College has a zerotolerance approach to AI-generated homework assignments. We see this as no different to getting someone else to do your homework or copying slabs of information from Google or a website. **True learning requires effort.** It requires a commitment to acquiring skills and knowledge. It requires growth and development. It gives us the ability to better understand our world and operate more efficiently within it.

Al generated homework provides none of this.

It actually disadvantages students ultimately robbing them of skills and knowledge that will allow them access to the better high schools and universities.

Our Policy:

Please understand that if we believe a student's work has been generated in part or wholly by AI, we may request a resubmission of work or mark the homework as incomplete.

We know you will appreciate our policy is in the **best interests** of YOUR child. That your child's original, personal homework efforts are acknowledged and valued. That they are not disadvantaged by 'Al cheating'. That they have a brighter academic future through genuine application to their studies.

For over 30 years, parents and students have put their trust in North Shore Coaching College to do what is right in the interest of a superior education for our students. We will continue to act in their best interests and support our families to the full extent of our abilities.

MyStudy: Online Homework

Our most frequently asked questions

QUESTION

What levels and subjects are MyStudy for?

ANSWER

As of Term 2, 2025, MyStudy is currently used in the following levels:

- Level 3 & 4: Maths & Thinking Skills only
- Level 5: English only

We are looking to expand it to other levels in the future, so keep an eye out for more updates!

QUESTION

My child forgot to go their MyStudy homework last week. Do they need to catch up this week?

ANSWER

Yes. MyStudy homework is **supposed to be completed each week** as students complete their physical booklets. Please ensure your child is up-to-date in their MyStudy homework as teachers monitor marks on a weekly basis.



OUESTION

Is MyStudy extra homework on top of the usual work in the physical workbook?

ANSWER

No. MyStudy is not 'extra' homework, but rather specific pages from the physical booklet being provided in an online format. That's why students should be treating and completing their MyStudy homework as they would their usual booklets.





QUESTION

What are the benefits for students?

ANSWER

Exposure to both traditional paper-and-pen and digital formats equips students with the skills needed for future academic tasks (like NAPLAN which is now digital with the exception of Year 3 writing).

Additionally, students are able to **receive immediate feedback** on their scores, as well as the **opportunity to easily review and reattempt incorrect questions**.



QUESTION

Will MyStudy replace all physical booklets in the future?

ANSWER


No, North Shore believes in a balance of both traditional and digital formats, which is why students will always be provided physical learning materials during their lessons.
