Don't forget to complete MyStudy online homework!

By now, all Level 3, 4, and 5 students should have established a routine of completing the online components of their homework weekly.

Please remember, MyStudy online homework is mandatory - these tasks must be completed alongside their physical booklets.

Abiding by Road Rules and Signage

As you may know, the two primary areas in front of our campus include a bus stop and a clearway zone (Sat 10AM-2PM). We would like to gently remind parents that stopping near a bus stop or in a clearway during the designated times is illegal and can result in fines ranging from \$333 to \$500.

We encourage parents arriving on campus during those times to find a legal parking spot and walk to campus to pick up/drop off students.

The Brisbane City Council clearly outline on their website that "it is illegal to stop in a 'No stopping' zone, regardless of the length of time you're there or even if the driver remains in the vehicle with the engine running". (Brisbane City Council, 2025)

North Shore Coaching College will not be responsible for any traffic fines incurred.

Bring Your Own Bottle!

We all know that staying hydrated is important for maintaining focus and energy throughout the school day.

This is why we ask all students to please remember to bring a named water bottle to North Shore - even if it's empty! Students can have their bottles refilled at the office if needed.

- Reduce interruptions to learning as students won't be leaving the classroom for water breaks.



PERMISSION TO LEAVE CAMPUS

Unless North Shore has received explicit written consent from parents, students are not permitted to leave campus unaccompanied at any time. Parents should be in the habit of walking to the campus to collect their children when classes conclude.

If you wish for your child to meet you in a designated area off campus, please email your campus manager.

High school students must remain on campus for the entirety of their lessons, leaving only when lessons end.

COLLECTING STUDENTS EARLY

For accountability reasons, if you need to pick up your child early from their classes for any reason, please inform your campus manager beforehand. This will allow them to prepare any booklets for missed lessons, if needed.

Once you are ready to collect your child, please proceed to the office, where staff will retrieve your child from their lesson.

Students will be asked to stay in class until parents arrive on campus.

FOLLOWING TRAFFIC RULES

Please remember to exercise caution when dropping off or picking up your children, ensuring that you are adhering to speed limits while on campus grounds.

To maintain a smooth flow of traffic and prevent traffic fines, please also make sure you are **not blocking driveways**, **bus stops and/or clearway zones**.

APPROPRIATE FOOTWEAR

To prevent accidents and injuries, we kindly ask that all students wear closed-in shoes. Please refrain from wearing thongs or slippers to class.

Additionally, **if your child is wearing shoes with laces, please ensure they know how to tie them**. Alternatively, consider shoes with velcro straps.

NO NUTS & GLASSWARE

All North Shore campuses are **nut-free centres** to ensure the safety and well-being of students with allergies. Please keep that in mind when packing snacks for your children.

Additionally, we ask that students do not bring glass containers or bottles to campus. This precaution helps prevent potential accidents and injuries from broken glass.



Online Student Support

If your child is struggling with a specific concept, or wanting some clarification during the week related to their North Shore work, we offer a variety of online student support options for you to explore!



Live Teacher Online Chat

Students can chat with our Online Teacher about their North Shore homework. Be as specific as possible when asking your question (eg. 'Level 6 Maths T1 W2 pg3 Q1') as teachers will be responding to students from various levels!

Leave the Teacher a Message

If your child needs help outside Live Chat hours, leave a message and the teacher will get back to you as soon as they can.

Fastrain Online Homework Videos

Level 3 - 5 students enrolled in the Fastrain core program are able to access videos which guide them page-by-page through their **Maths** and **Thinking Skills homework**.

A Note on **Online Portal Use**

Messages and chat logs are monitored regularly. Abuse and inappropriate use of the chat or messaging features will result in severe consequences.

Please make sure you and your child keep your account information safe, and under no circumstances share or 'lend' them to anyone else - including fellow North Shore students. Any mis-use can be traced back to you.


